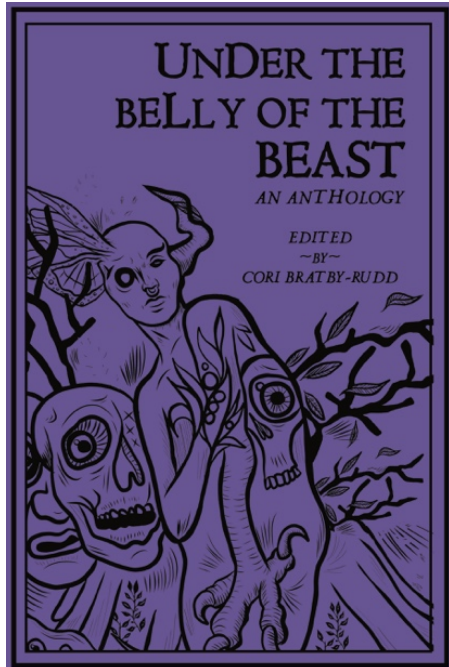


## *What is Beauty? What makes a Beast?*
